GUAMÁ, CIENFUEGOS AND TRINIDAD WITH OVERNIGHT IN CIENFUEGOS Y TRINIDAD

Day # 1: Excursion to Guamá-Ciénaga de Zapata.

Day # 2: Sightseeing Cienfuegos.

Day # 3: Sightseeing Trinidad.

DAY 1 PROGRAM: EXCURSION TO GUAMÁ - CIÉNAGA DE ZAPATA

*This is a very interesting destination for its unique nature and its historic connotation. In a beach of this peninsula and swamp, **Playa Girón**, was defected in April 1961; in less than 72 hours, an invasion financed and equipped by the CIA and the USA Government to overthrow the revolutionary government.*

a) *Departure at 9:00 AM.*

b) **Arrival to Guamá** at around 11:00.

c) *Visit to the largest **crocodile farm** in Cuba.*

d) *Boat excursion trough the **Laguna del Tesoro** to visit a replica of a Taino village with sculptures and other recalls of the Cuban aboriginal past.*

e) *Lunch*

f) Visit to the **Playa Girón Museum**

g) **Visit to Cueva de los Peces.** A cave with crystalline waters in which you can swim surround by fishes. **Perfect for snorkeling.**

h) **Travel to Cienfuegos.**

i) Check in one of the best houses of rent in this city. You will see pictures of the booked accommodation.

j) **Free activities at night** always with transportation support.

DAY 2 PROGRAM: SIGHTSEEING CIENFUEGOS

This city, also known as **the Pearl of the South or Pretty City of the Sea**, was founded by French settlers in 1819. Its location, surrounding **the Jagua Bay** and its eclectic architecture make Cienfuegos one of the most beautiful cities in Cuba. It has been recognized as **World Heritage by UNESCO**. It is located 260 kms of Havana.

a) Breakfast at the booked house.

b) Route by **Paseo del Prado de Cienfuegos**.

c) **Visit to Parque José Martí**, the central Park of the city. This is the biggest central park in Cuba and in it stands the only Arch of Triumph in Cuba. Next to the park are emblematic buildings of the city as **the Tomás Terry Theater**, the building of the town council, The San Lorenzo School and the Goitizolo Palace (current House of the Culture). Next to the park is the boulevard, also very attractive.

d) **Visit to Punta Gorda**; the most beautiful neighborhood of Cienfuegos located in the peninsula of the same name that stretches out in the bay. Among the main sightseeing of this area is the Cienfuegos Malecón, The Cienfuegos Palace, the Valle Palace and the Jagua Hotel.

e) **Stop for lunch at Villa Lagarto**, a lovely villa located at the tip of the peninsula right next to the waters of the bay. (not included in the price of the excursion).

f) **Visit to the Tomas Acea Cemetery** famous for its portico that copies the Parthenon.

g) **Visit to Botanic Garden of Cienfuegos**; the oldest of Latin America founded more than 100 years with expert advice of the Harvard University. It has the biggest collection of Palms in Cuba.

h) Departure to Trinidad.

i) Check in one of the best houses of rent in Trinidad (we will send you pictures of it).

j) Dinner at the booked house.

k) **Free activities at night.**

DAY 3 PROGRAM: SIGHTSEEING TRINIDAD

The town of **Santísima Trinidad de Cuba**, the city-museum or the city stopped in the time, as it is also known, will make you travel back in time and feel as if you were in a Spanish colonial village of the 18th - 19th century. **Founded in 1514**, is one of the first seven villages founded in Cuban and one of the oldest in the whole American continent. Because of its fantastic architecture and its historical and cultural values Trinidad was declared **World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1988**.

a) **Breakfast** at the booked house.

b) Long walk around the Historic Center of the city: Visit to Plaza Mayor; The

museums Romantico and Palacio Cantero as well as the Parroquial Mayor.

c) Visit to Parque El Cubano.

*d) Lunch at **restaurant Estilo Gourmet** with a nice environment and view of Trinidad. (not included in the price of the excursion).*

*e) **Visit to Valle de los Ingenios** and the property and tower-view point of the former sugar farm of the family Manaca Iznaga. This tower; with 48 meters, is the highest construction of the Colonial times in Cuba.*

f) Return to Havana around 3:30 PM.
